TO REGISTER THROUGH YOUR CHURCH

- All retreats will be held at the Nunemaker Center at Holmes Presbyterian Camp and Conference Center, a ski-lodge type facility with fireplaces, bunk beds, and places for recreation.
- Registation/Arrival will be on Friday at 7 pm, with pizza served at 7:30 pm. The retreat will conclude with Saturday dinner at 6 pm.
- 3. Bring a pillow and pillowcase, blankets and sheets or a sleeping bag. Also bring towels, toiletry items, clothing and shoes for the season, pajamas and a Bible. Remember: The temperature at camp is 10 to 15 degrees colder than that at home!


