It depends on the number of women who sign up for the retreat. Main meeting/dining room off main kitchen seats 100 for meals, 150 for assemblies, media and sound system equipped, piano available. Upstairs meeting room seats 25, also media equipped, with sink; lounge nook with three sofas and a TV-VCR. Entry lounge seats 15 for

registration and small gatherings. The main focal point of Agape is Charlotte's Room, with it's unusual shaped walls of glass and unique ceiling lighting. It is a fully equipped meeting room for 50 to 75 people with a baby grand piano. Full linen and meal service.
